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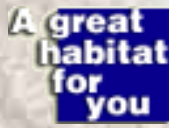
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## Corbett Hideaway's Himalayan Jeep Safari



### DAY 01: Delhi/Corbett National Park (280 kms/06 hr)

Depart early morning by jeep to Corbett National Park (7 hr/ 300 km). Arrive at noon. Take lunch, take a guided nature walk and also visit the famous Garjia temple. Overnight stay at Claridges Corbett Hideaway.

### DAY 02: Corbett National Park

Early morning game drive by jeep, return to Hideaway for breakfast. Rest, relax and lunch. Evening game viewing by elephant. Cultural program on the dances of Kumaon. Overnight Claridges Hideaway.

### DAY 03: Corbett National Park

After breakfast drive to Binsar, enroute we drive through the sanctuary. Binsar offers a lot of opportunities to the avid birders and photographers. Overnight stay at Binsar Tourist Rest House.

### DAY 04: Binsar/ Munsiyari (192 km/ 06 hr)

A steep ascent on a hillside replete with villages, streams and waterfalls brings you to a quaint little township of Munsiyari, perched on a mountain face. Munsiyari commands fantastic views of the Panchchuli peaks and the Milam and Ralam valleys. The majority of the population is of the ethnic Bhotia race, a very tough breed, invaluable as guides and porters or the various treks that begin here. Overnight stay at the Wayfarer's Resort.

### DAY 05: Munsiyari

Khaliya Top is situated approximate 11 Km from the Wayfarer's Resort, at a height of 11500 ft. This hilltop offers an incredible view of the Panchchuli peaks. The highly popular trek to Khaliya Top through dense forest and overnight stay in alpine tents, is a must.

### DAY 06: Munsiyari

For those fond of angling there is ample scope to fish trout and Mahseer in the Ramganga and Gori Ganga rivers within radius of 40 Kms. Separate arrangement for guide and packed lunch can be made. Guests are expected to bring along their own angling equipment.

OR

Lilam Village- situated approximately 13 kms from The Wayfarer's Resort; This trek is a part of the Milam Glacier Route along the banks of Gori Ganga through the villages of Darkot, Dumar & Jimighat. The trek offers an initial experience of the flora and fauna of the Johar valley.

**DAY 07: Munsiyari / Patal Bhubaneshwar /Chaukori (250 kms)**

Drive to Patal Bhubaneshwar (05 Hrs), spend 02 Hrs visiting Magmite / Stalmitite caves which depicts the legends of The Mahabhart, the great Indian epic, and then to Chaukori. Chaukori a small Kumaoni Village, has tea gardens with enchanting views of the Himalayas. The road to Chaukori is along the famous Berinag ridge. Overnight stay in a Tourist Rest House.

**DAY 08: Chaukori/ Mukteshwar/ Ramgarh (260 kms / 07 hr)**

Drive in the morning to Mukteshwar through narrow roads dotted with villages. This area is famous as the fruit bowl of the Kumaon. Apple, pear and peach orchards cover the hillsides with their splendid blossoms. Overnightstay at Mountain View Resort.

**DAY 09: Ramgarh / Delhi (350 kms / 08 hr)**

Drive back to Delhi in the morning. Arrive Delhi in the evening.

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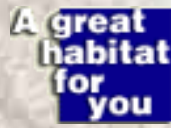
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## The Corbett Hideaway Elephant Jeep Safari



An exclusive elephant safari in the periphery areas of Corbett Tiger Reserve. The safari takes you through mysterious thick forests, deep valleys and the rugged trails.

This thrilling elephant safari is in the style of yester years, where the grandeur of the 'British Raj' is relived in old forest rest houses (FRH), built in 1890'S. To satiate the jungle appetite you are accompanied by our cooks specialising in Indian/ Continental cuisine. To help you appreciate the environment, you are accompanied by a language speaking naturalist.

For transport and backup services we provide 4WD jeeps which are best suited for the terrain of Corbett.

### Day 1:

**0630 Hr.:** Depart early from New Delhi to arrive for lunch at the Claridges Corbett Hideaway, Garjia. The resort is situated in the fringe areas of Corbett National Park, overlooking the Kosi river. You drive through the rich agricultural belt of Western U.P. and the city of Moradabad, famous for its brass and silverware.

**1330 Hr.:** Check in. Lunch and enjoy the expanse of the resort.

**1500 Hr.:** A nature walk accompanied by a Naturalist, along the Kosi River, to the famous Garjia Devi Temple. This area is a Birdwatchers Paradise.

**1730 Hr.:** Reach back to the Resort for a refreshing cup of tea.

**1900 Hr.:** Orientation talk and a Question & Answer session on your tour, followed by a slide show on the flora and fauna of the area you will visit.

**2000 Hr.:** Dinner. Overnight.

**Day 2:**

**0600Hr.:** Wake up call followed by breakfast.

**0700 Hr.:** We depart for a jeep safari in Corbett National Park, with packed lunch, to find the elusive tiger. The Corbett Park, with its varied topography, diverse flora and fauna, the meandering Ramganga river, the natural splendour of its landscapes, is a precious heritage.

We drive along the Ramganga, to look for the long snouted, fish eating Gharial and Marsh Crocodiles, Kingfishers, Palls and Himalayan Greyheaded Fishing Eagle.

**1300 Hr.:** We arrive at Dhikala, the natural setting is awesome. Lunch, rest, relax and enjoy the panoramic view of the grassland area and its abundant wildlife.

**1500 Hr.:** The elephant ride from Dhikala is an introduction to the wildlife viewing experience before you in in Tiger country.

**1700 Hr.:** Jeep to Garial Lodge for Overnight stay.

**2000 Hr.:** After a wash and brief rest join the naturalist for discussion and dinner.

**Day 3:**

**0600 Hr.:** Wake up call/Tea.

**0630 Hr.:** Early morning Jeep Safari in the Garial area and into the awesome wilderness of the park and beyond.

**0830 Hr.:** We arrive at the Claridges Corbett for breakfast. Wash/ change.

**1000 Hr.:** Travel by Jeep to commence Elephant Safari. Enroute visit Kanda situated at an elevation of 1020m, where Jim Corbett shot the Kanda man-eater. This being the highest point of the Park the overall view of the Ramganga valley and reservoir is phenomenal.

**1330 Hr.:** After a picnic lunch we start the Elephant Safari. The Himalayan foothills are one of the natural wonders of the earth, with lush sub tropical forests and the bountiful flora and avifauna. Being on an elephant is an incredible experience. The elephant is a silent bulldozer whose unmatched cross country abilities are unexplainable in words. You can change seats with the Mahout and get the feel of driving an elephant.

**1830 Hr.:** We arrive after leisurely driving/riding our magnificent companion at Rathuadab Forest Rest House, built in characteristic British bungalow style, in the year 1898. Overnight stay in the wilderness.

**2000 Hr.:** After tea - wash/rest. Later on we discuss the next days program over a sumptuous dinner.

**Day 04:**

**0600 Hr.:** Wake up call. Tea.

**0630 Hr.:** We start a complete full day on elephant back, stopping enroute at a picturesque spot to have breakfast. The bird life in this lower altitude wilderness is rich. The morning sun sets the hills on fire.

1430 Hr.: Start elephant safari for the Sonanadi Sanctuary, going along the rocky plain river, the forested areas and scenery is spectacular with a visual feast of wildlife and birds.

1830 Hr.: We arrive at Halduparao Forest Rest House built in 1899 which was broken down by wild elephants and abandoned. The Sonanadi Sanctuary was included in the Corbett Tiger Reserve and this Forest Rest House was restored a few years ago.

2000 Hr.: After a hot water bucket wash/bath, we get together at a campfire - where the elephants drivers and other camp and forest staff join in to tell stories of their experiences in the wild. Dinner. Overnight.

**Day 5:**

0600 Hr.: Wake up call. Tea.

0630 Hr.: Option of either going for an elephant ride/jeep safari or nature walk with an armed guard in the Sonanadi Sanctuary area, for wildlife viewing.

0900 Hr.: After breakfast we depart from this paradise on earth, by jeep with packed lunch via Sendhikhal / Saneh / Morghatti / Kalagarh / Jhirna / Dhela / Ramnagar, reaching Claridges Corbett by late evening - after completing a full circle around India's oldest National Park. **(Consult Map).**

2000 Hr.: After enjoying the comfort of modern toilet and shower facilities- talk about your fantastic experience. Cocktails and dinner.

**Day 6:**

After breakfast depart for the next destination.

**NOTE:**

Rathuadab / Halduparao FRH have basic accommodation on Twin / Triple sharing basis with non-flushing, Indian style toilets. But other amenities are clean linen, good food, and wonderful wild experiences!

Timings are subject to local conditions and are liable to change.

- Afternoon free. Relax at the riverside.
- Cultural show/ folk dances
- Overnight at the hotel

### Day 4

- Early breakfast at the hotel
- Departure by pony for Sitabani/ Powalgarh with packed lunch
- Ride on to Kotabagh/ Dhachauri
- Overnight at Forest Rest House/ Camp

**Day 5**

- Early breakfast
- Departure by pony for Pangot
- Overnight in camp  
(Jeeps to service from Nainital)

**Day 6**

- Early breakfast
- Pony trek continues to Nainital
- Lunch at The Claridges Naini Retreat, Nainital
- Relaxation time

**Day 7**

- Breakfast in the hotel
- Full day in Nainital
- Boating, walk etc
- Evening drinks at Boat Club House
- Dinner at the hotel

- Departure from the hotel

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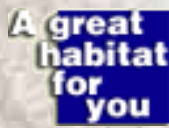


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## The Claridges Corbett Hideaway Bird Watching Safari 2 nights/ 3 days

Over 600 species of birds including Hornbill , Barbets , Woodpeckers and other woodland avifauna in pure sal stands and mixed forest.

### DAY I

**0600 Hrs** Departure from Delhi.

**1230 Hrs** Arrival at the hotel.

**1330 Hrs** Lunch.

**1600 Hrs** An afternoon siesta for those who wish to relax. For enthusiasts, bird watching cum nature walk (1hour) accompanied by Mr Imran Khan the naturalist of Corbett Hideaway.

**1800 Hrs** Tea/coffee with cookies

**1930 Hrs** Assemble for orientation programme and slide/video show.

**2030 Hrs** Dinner.

### DAY II

**0530 Hrs** Morning tea

**0600 Hrs** Jungle Safari in jeeps accompanied by guides.

**0930 Hrs** Breakfast

**1100 Hrs** Trip to local village and Garjia Temple

**1300 Hrs** Lunch

**1430 Hrs** Bird Watching trip along with the naturalist

**1800 Hrs** Tea/coffee

**1900 Hrs** Kumaoni cultural program around the bonfire

**2030 Hrs** Dinner

**2130 Hrs** Discussions with Naturalist & Movie on wild life (optional)

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## The Corbett Hideaway Anglers Tour

Though the best fishing season is from February through April, fishing is permitted from October onwards.

**DAY 01:** Arrive at Corbett Hideaway, Garjia for lunch. Afternoon / Evening a guided nature walk through the famous Garjia Devi Temple or a Jeep Safari to the Brijani Forest for game viewing. Return by sunset. Slide show on the flora and fauna of Corbett. Overnight stay.

**DAY 02:** Early morning drive to Ramganga river to commence fishing. Lunch and rest.- Continue fishing upto sunset. Return to Corbett Hideaway - special dinner. Overnight.

**DAY 03:** Morning drive to another angling spot to fish. Packed lunch will be provided. The Ramganga river offers deep pools and fast flowing rapids for a fishing stretch of 14 Kms. Fish upto sunset. Return to Corbett Hideaway. Overnight.

**DAY 04:** Departure after breakfast.

This itinerary can be extended by adding additional days for angling, if desired. Being a special interest sport, anglers have to organise all equipment independently. Details of suitable tackle can be provided.

### Services

- The Hideaway arranges fishing permits and Gillees (local).
- Fishing Guides are provided on the tour, locals who know the river as well as the back of their hands! They will suggest to you the best beats in the river.
- Jeeps will be available for transportation to and from fishing beats.

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
